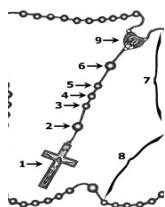

May God rebuke Him, we humbly pray, and do Thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and his evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.



**PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS:** God, thank you for loving me. You have called me to live as your child. Help all your children to love you and one another. Amen.

**ACT OF CONTRITION:** O my God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. **AFTER MEALS:** We give Thee thanks, Almighty God, for all thy benefits, who lives and reigns, world without end. Amen.

**PRAYER BEFORE A DAY'S WORK:** Direct, we beg you, O Lord, our actions by your holy inspirations, and grant that we may carry them out with your gracious assistance, that every prayer and work of ours may begin always with you, and through you be happily ended. Amen



**GUARDIAN ANGEL PRAYER:** Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom His love commits me here, ever this day [night] be at my side to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.



## NICENE CREED:

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all that visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation, he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake, he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried, and rose on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son he is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the Prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church. I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins, and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.



**THE SERENITY PRAYER:** God grant me the serenity to accept the things I cannot change. The courage to change the things I can, and wisdom to know the difference. ## DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET:

1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross

2. *Opening Prayer:* You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. (Repeat three times): O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. Our Father

4. Hail Mary

5. The Apostle's Creed

6. *Prayer on each Our Father bead:* Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7. *Prayer on each Hail Mary Beads:* For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

8. Repeat for the remaining decades.

9. *Conclusion:* Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Repeat three times).

10. *Closing Prayer:* Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.
